Thank You for Helping Us Keep Our Children Safe during the School Day

Here are things you can do to continue to keep your child safe:

1. Cross at the crosswalk using the traffic light.
2. Teach your child to be a good citizen by obeying the law, traffic safety patrol team, and school personnel.
3. Be an example to your child by using the crosswalk yourself, obeying the traffic laws and school safety personnel.
4. Pick up your child at the parking lot, at the rear of the school or meet your child after he/she crosses at the light.
5. Please stay away from the "Cone Zone" and do not cross the street when the cones are set up.

We will do the following to keep your child safe:

1. Give you a reminder when your actions are unsafe.
2. Give your child a verbal warning (they know the rules).
3. Safety Patrol Team records license plates and descriptions of violators.
4. Aurora Police will issue warnings to violators.
5. Aurora Police will issue tickets to those that persist in breaking the law.

Remember:

- Every year we hear about children being injured due to crossing disasters.
- Every year a parent has to deal with grief because the child or parent did not obey the traffic laws.
- Every year we want to improve on reducing traffic accidents and injury to a child.

Sign in After 8:00 am Bell

Parents we are having a lot of students come late to school on a daily basis. Some students are walking around outside after they are dropped off for quite a while. We have found students on the playground unsupervised after the bell has rung. To ensure the safety of our students parents will need to walk their child to the front office and sign their child in once the 8:00 am bell rings. There will be 3 large signs in yellow and black that will remind you of this as well as staff members outside. Please make sure you are on time to school every day. The first bell rings at 7:55 am – this is a reminder to students to line up in their spots for arrival. The 2nd bell rings at 7:57; teachers will walk outside at this time and greet students and families. The 3rd bell rings at 8:00 am and this is the bell to come inside to start the school day. If your child is late every day for 10 minutes this is 29 instructional hours students have now missed for the school year. This time adds up very quickly. If your children are not here we are not able to teach them.

Inclement Weather

During inclement weather periods, we will mark the front office doors with a "red dot", signaling IN-SIDE line-up. This means that all students will enter through their normal doors from the playground or front of school, which will be staffed and opened by our Para Educators so that students can enter immediately and proceed to their classroom hallways.
